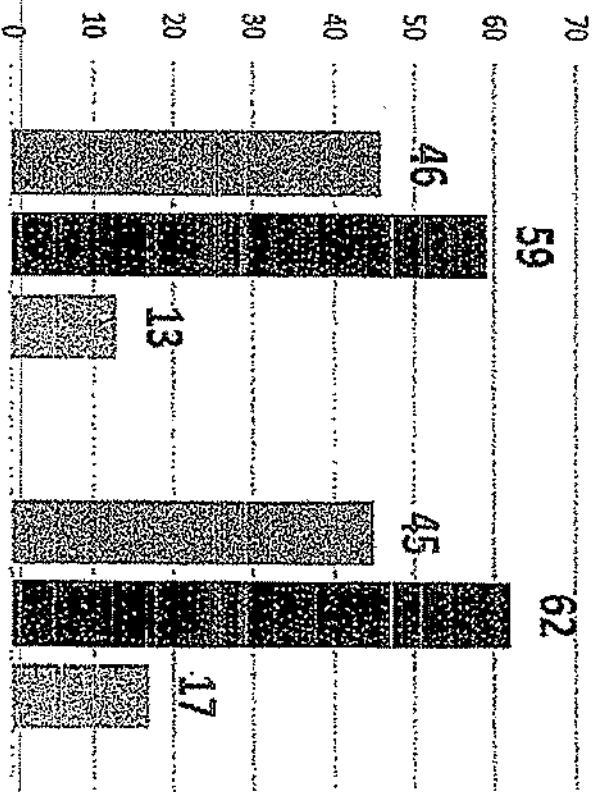

Information:

- Students who score a level 3 on 7th grade FAST may not have received any Algebra prerequisites if they were in Regular 7th Grade Math



- Students who go into Algebra in 8th grade are more likely to be successful on the EOC. Students only need to score a Level 3 on the EOC to receive credit which is the equivalent of 50%
