- III. Principal's Welcome/Update- Mr. Toliver
 - Student Recognition & Events: Celebrated students for their classroom achievements and character traits with certificates of recognition. Highlighted simultaneous events, including MTL and the 5000 Role Model Induction Ceremony.
 - Upcoming Opportunities: Announced Saturday School this weekend for extra tutoring and discussed PM2 testing for mid-year assessments, scheduled for December and January.

 - School Environment Safety Incident Reporting
 - There were four incidents this month involving three medium-level student conflicts and one safetyrelated issue, a manageable number for a student population of 995.

VI. Title One Updates – Mrs. Rodriguez

- **Title I Funding Requirements**: To maintain funding, the school must collect 75% of parent compacts and 10% participation in the Title I survey by mid-February. Parents are encouraged to complete and return these forms promptly.
- **Financial Literacy Workshop**: A virtual Title I parent night on financial literacy will be held tonight at 7:00 PM. Parents can join by scanning the provided QR code.
- **Title I Binder Progress**: The school has completed 74% of the required documentation for the Title I binder and is on track with its submission process.

VII. SIP Updates-Mrs. Mckie

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- **ELO and Test Preparation**: Focused on supporting students with extended learning opportunities (ELO) for FAST and i-Ready assessments in reading, math, science, social studies, and civics. Additional morning sessions (Monday-Thursday) provide homework help and targeted practice for 6th-8th graders, with pull-out groups targeting specific student needs.
- Saturday School: Available from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM for extra academic support in algebra, geometry, and other subjects to help students achieve proficiency by the end of the year.
- Interim Grades & Parent Support: Second-quarter interim grades will be posted on Friday, November 22. Parents are encouraged to review their child's progress, schedule conferences if needed, and stay informed as the quarter ends on January 10.

VIII.Kids of Character- October – Mrs. Rodriguez

- Student of the Month Recognition: Students were selected as "Kids of Character" for their
 outstanding citizenship based on nominations from multiple teachers, highlighting their exemplary
 behavior and contributions.
