I. Call to order /Introductions

- The meeting was called to order at 5:00PM by Ms. Williams. A quorum of voting members was present at the meeting.

II. Approval of Previous Meeting

- Motion to accept the minutes as read was made by Mrs. Rodriguez & seconded by Mrs. Bonita

III. Principal's Welcome/Update- Mr. Toliver

I. Parents and staff were invited to attend the Science Fair following the meeting to observe student projects and activities.

II. School Recognition (A+ bonus) funds of \$74,727 were distributed equally to eligible staff and will be paid at the end of February.

III. Encouragement for families to follow school communication platforms (website, social media, and school accounts) for updates and events.

IV. Financial Report: **Accountability Starting Balance: \$17,479.00**

Instructional Materials Fund Balance: \$2,955.37

Total: \$20,291.37

- A proposal was made by Mrs. Rodriguez to allocate \$7000 of the school accountability funds to support extended learning opportunities due to reduced Title I funding. All 10 voting members present voted yay for \$7000 from accountability funds to be used for Saturday school ELO.

V. School Environment Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR)– Mr. Perez

- SESIR definition was reviewed (only qualifying incidents are reported to the state).
- Since the last SAC meeting, there has been one incident – A fight occurred and was addressed through discipline and parent involvement.
- Administration is continuing interventions and monitoring to prevent future incidents.

VI. School improvement Plan Monitoring and Stakeholders Feedback (SIP) Updates– Mrs. Mckie

- School goals include increasing proficiency from 51% to 54% in ELA, Math, and Science, and from 70% to 73% in Civics, with focus on students with disabilities.
- PM1 to PM2 data showed gains, including a 10-point increase in ELA proficiency and a 17-point increase in Math proficiency.
- Saturday School, digital programs, remediation groups, and co-teaching supports will continue to help students meet proficiency goals.

VII. Title One Updates – Mrs. Rodriguez

- Parent engagement opportunities include curriculum nights, prevention night, and annual Title I meetings.
- Parent feedback indicated a need for improved communication and earlier sharing of FAST testing and FOCUS access information.
- Staff training will focus on strengthening school-home partnerships and communication with families.

VIII. Kids of Character – Mrs. Rodriguez

- Students were recognized for positive behavior, leadership, and academic effort.
- Certificates and photos were provided to celebrate student achievements.
- Families were thanked for supporting student success and engagement.

IX. Questions, Concerns and Comments

- Parents were invited to provide input regarding school programs and improvement efforts.
- Community events were announced including Autism Awareness activities and participation opportunities.
- Extended learning and parent involvement opportunities were discussed.
