

I. Call to Order / Introductions

- The meeting was called to order at 8:46 AM by Ms. Williams

II. Approval of Previous Meeting

- Motion to accept the minutes as read was made by Mrs. Rodriguez & seconded by Dr. Spence

III. School Improvement Plan (SIP) Updates – Mrs. McKie

- Updates were provided regarding Benchmark Standard Assessments (BSA) for Civics, Algebra, and Biology.
- Academic supports include Morning ELO sessions (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday) and Saturday ELO sessions from 9:00–12:00 for Math, Science, and Reading.
- Study Island was implemented to support 7th grade Civics instruction and assessment preparation.

IV. School Environment Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR) – Mr. Perez

- Mr. Perez reviewed behavior incidents that require reporting to the state.
- For the month of March, there were no SESIR reportable incidents.
- The administration continues monitoring student behavior to maintain a safe school environment.

V. Title I Updates – Mrs. Rodriguez

- Title I programs and services were reported to be progressing successfully.
- Parent engagement and communication efforts continue to support student success.
- Families are encouraged to remain involved in school programs and school decision-making.

VI. Kids of Character – Mrs. Rodriguez

- Students were recognized for demonstrating excellent self-control and positive character traits.
- Teachers nominated students who consistently demonstrate leadership and responsibility.
- Recognition continues to promote a positive school culture.

- Updates were shared regarding collaboration with Sea Castles Elementary and community partnerships.
- Parents were encouraged to participate in SAC meetings and school decision-making.

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Financial Report: **Accountability Starting Balance: \$10,479.00**

- The accountability fund balance discussed was approximately \$10,479.

- Suggested purchases included instructional materials, academic supports, and equipment for student learning.
