I. Welcome/Call to order

- I. The meeting was called to order at 8:40AM by Ms. Burke

II. Reading of the minutes from our last meeting

- I. Motion to accept the minutes as read was made by Mr. Scott and seconded by Mr. Patterson

III. Principal's Welcome/Update- Mr. Toliver

- I. Parent nights, including Math, Science, and ESE events, were a success thanks to strong parent and teacher participation.
- II. Track season has begun with the school as defending regional champions, and upcoming awards ceremonies will recognize third quarter and end-of-year achievements.

- II. Since the last SAC meeting on February 27, there were four state-reportable incidents—three for tobacco possession and one fight—marking a decrease due to improved security measures and conflict resolution efforts.

VI. Title One Updates – Ms. Burke

- I. Title One is wrapping up successfully with 98% of documents approved and today marks the final meeting required for documentation.
- II. Next year's parent events will include the Annual Title One/Open House, ESOL Parent Night, and Prevention Night, with staff training planned on effective parent communication and Focus platform usage.
- III. The school-parent compact will remain the same for next year, though some learning path items are still outstanding.

VII. SIP Updates– Mrs. Mckie



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- I. The school is on track with its improvement goals, showing growth in ELA proficiency from 43% to 47% and focusing on supporting underperforming students with disabilities through differentiated instruction.
- II. Acceleration efforts have improved, with a decrease to 68%, and progress on math goals and FAST PM2 assessments indicates overall positive momentum, with a call for continued parent support in extended learning opportunities.

**VIII. Library Updates – Mrs. Sangster**

- I. The media center holds about 10,800 books with an average collection age of 2003, exceeding the 15-year guideline, though the school meets the requirement of 10 books per student.
- II. A three-year plan is in place to update the collection, starting with weeding out older fiction and biographies while continuously ordering new books to address content gaps and ensure compliance.

**IX. Kids of Character– Ms. Burke**

- I. Student of the Month Recognition: Students were selected as "Kids of Character" based on nominations from multiple teachers, highlighting their exemplary behavior and contributions.
- II. Parent Appreciation: Acknowledged the role of parents in fostering these character traits, emphasizing how their support positively impacts student success.


