I. Welcome/Call to order

The meeting was called to order by Mrs. A. Williams at 5:02 p.m.

II. Reading of the minutes from our last meeting

The minutes from the previous meeting was read and the motion to accept the minutes as read was made by Ms. Burke and seconded by Ms. Bishop.

III. Principal's Welcome/Update- Mr. Toliver

- ❑ **Student Achievements:** Significant improvements in civics, math, and ELA across all grades; only two percentage points away from a B school rating, with a focus on reaching an A this year.
- ❑ **Goals for the New Year:** The school is prepared and excited to continue progress, with strong plans in place for reaching higher academic achievements.
- ❑ **Fundraiser Announcement:** Texas Roadhouse fundraiser scheduled for Tuesday 9/10 , 5-9 PM, where 10% of proceeds will go to the school. Flyers will be available during open house.

IV. Financial Report: **Accountability Starting Balance: \$ 14,423.81**

V.SESIR Data for (School Environment Safety Incident Reporting) New Renaissance Middle School – Mr. Perez

- ❑ No school environmental safety incidents have been reported so far this year. If any occur, they will be shared at future SAC meetings.

VI. Title One Updates – Mrs. Rodriguez

- ❑ **Budget and Programs:** The Title One budget has been approved, which supports additional classes for struggling students. School-parent compacts need to be signed by 75% of parents and students to maintain the budget.
- ❑ **Parent Documents:** Highly qualified teacher documents and parent rights letters were sent home with the first-day packets. Parents are encouraged to review these for important information about their rights and the qualifications of their child's teachers.

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VII. SIP Updates– Mrs. Mckie

- ❑ **Performance Highlights:** The school is two percentage points away from earning a "B" rating, with a focus on reaching an "A" this year. Civics saw an 18% improvement, but challenges remain in 8th grade science and middle school acceleration courses (algebra, geometry, biology).
- ❑ **Areas of Focus:** Key goals for improvement include ELA, math, and science, particularly targeting students with disabilities, aiming for 41% proficiency. Strategies include implementing curriculum with fidelity, station teaching, and differentiated instruction.

VIII. Yearbook Committee – Mrs. Ealy

- ❑ This year's yearbook will be 99% student-driven, with students involved in writing, graphic design, and filming. The yearbook class will lead the process under teacher guidance.

IX. SAC and SAF dates: The dates of the monthly SAC and SAF meetings were presented.

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





