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### **SCHOOL ADVISORY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES DRAFT**

#### I. Welcome/Call to order

- I. The meeting was called to order at 8:37AM by Ms. Burke

#### II. Reading of the minutes from our last meeting

- I. Motion to accept the minutes as read was made by Mr. Scott and seconded by Mr. Patterson. We did not have quorum to accept the minutes from the previous meeting.

#### III. Principal's Welcome/Update- Mr. Toliver

- o Book Fair, ESOL Parent Night (tonight), and Report Cards (November 5th). ELO sessions run Monday-Thursday from 8 AM - 9 AM.
- o Testing adjustments from previous years, ongoing construction nearing completion with most areas fully painted. Hurricane make-up days scheduled.
- o i-Ready Challenge for Math and ELA, and a cell phone survey for staff, parents, and students.

#### IV. Financial Report: **Accountability Starting Balance: \$ 14,423.81**

#### V. Kids of Character- September – Ms. Jones

- o Student's demonstrating the character trait of Cooperation

#### VI. Overview of District and State Assessments - Mrs. Knowles – Bryant

- o State and district tests - PM1 and i-Ready, track student progress. Initial low PM1 scores are expected since students haven't learned all standards yet. These results help teachers tailor lessons and support.
- o Elementary, middle, and high school students have specific score requirements for promotion and graduation.
- o Parents can use the Focus Portal to view their child's test scores and track progress.

#### VII. SESIR Data for New Renaissance Middle School – Mr. Perez

- o School Environment Safety Incident Reporting
- o Since the last SAC meeting on September 5, there have been three reportable fights but no incidents involving weapons or drugs.
- o Preventive Measures: To reduce incidents, the school has adjusted safety personnel placements, increased monitoring, and implemented conflict mediation to address potential conflicts proactively. The goal is to see zero incidents by the next SAC meeting in November.

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**Title One Updates – Mr. Perez**

- The school still needs about 250 Title One parent compacts to reach the 75% requirement. Currently, 28% of Title One documents are approved, with 19% awaiting approval.
- The Title One survey is out, and only 10% of parents need to complete it. A QR code has been provided for easy access. Title One funding provides federal support for additional school resources and activities.

**IX. SIP Updates– Mrs. Knowles – Bryant**

- The school aims for 40% of students to reach level three or higher on assessments. Civics scores rose by 18% this year, with a small 1% drop in science. Focus areas include boosting ELA, 8th-grade science, and high school course pass rates.
- The school is using differentiated instruction and learning stations to meet different learning styles, with a focus on ESE students. Teachers are receiving training, including i-Ready, to improve instruction and engagement.
- Students have access to morning tutoring, i-Ready practice, and an after-school reading club. The goal is for students to complete 45 minutes of i-Ready each week and pass at least two lessons.
