I. Call to order /Introductions

I. The meeting was called to order at 5:03PM by Ms. Burke

II. Approval of Previous Meeting

I. Motion to accept the minutes as read was made by Mrs. Mckie & Mrs. Knowles-Bryant

III. Principal's Welcome/Update- Mr. Toliver

- I. District's Reimagining Middle Schools initiative, noting NRMS is being reviewed for increased enrollment rather than closure.
- II. The school is preparing for possible re-boundary changes and has the capacity to welcome additional students.
- III. Before-school tutoring and support will begin soon, along with the launch of Saturday Success Academy to assist students in core subjects.
- IV. PM2 testing is scheduled for early December, and families were encouraged to support students with rest, preparation, and continued learning.
- V. Upcoming schoolwide events include the Harvest Drive, Relief for Jamaica collection, Honor Roll Ceremony, JA Finance field trips, and participation in the City of Miramar Tree Lighting.

IV. Financial Report: **Accountability Starting Balance: \$ 17, 479.00**

I. Previous SAC accountability balance: **\$14,423.81.**

- Unused funds from the previous year.
- Unused ClassWallet funds rolling into SAC (teachers were reminded to use ClassWallet).

II. Funds will be considered for:

- Student improvement initiatives.
- Supporting the Extended Learning Opportunities (ELO) program and tutoring.
- Possible student celebrations.

V. School Environment Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR)– Mr. Perez

- I. SESIR definition was reviewed (only qualifying incidents are reported to the state).
- II. Since the last SAC meeting, there has been one vaping incident involving an 8th grade student.

Administration is addressing the issue through counseling, education, and preventative measures.

- IV. Members expressed appreciation that only one state-reportable incident occurred, indicating current procedures are effective.

VI. Media Center Update – Ms. Sangster

- I. Current average age of the library collection is approximately 2004.
- II. NRMS has about 11 books per student.
- III. Approximately 69% of the collection is considered "aged."
- IV. The goal is to bring the average collection age closer to 2015 and reduce the aged percentage to around 50%.
- V. Plan moving forward:
 - Weed outdated fiction and biography titles.
 - Replace with newer books and updated copyrights.

VII. School Improvement Plan Monitoring and Stakeholders Feedback (SIP) Updates– Mrs. Mckie

- I. School Improvement Plan has been approved, with major focus areas including improving math outcomes for the bottom 25% and increasing SWD performance from 43% to 49%.
- II. The school aims to raise overall math proficiency from 51% to 54% through targeted supports such as stations, small groups, before-school tutoring, and Saturday Success remediation.
- III. Students are expected to complete 45 minutes weekly in I-Ready Reading and Math, with the next diagnostic opening the first week of January.

VIII. Title One Updates – Ms. Burke

- I. NRMS is currently at 60% completion of its Title I requirements for the school year.
- II. A Title I Parent Training session will be held on Thursday, November 13 at 6:00 p.m., with flyers available for families.
- III. Parents were encouraged to complete the Title I survey, as only about 25 of the required 100 responses have been submitted.




