Parents also get a text message with a copy of the information. The goal of the face plan is to make it a welcoming environment. We also have books an a little table. Mr. Weinkopf said the front office looks amazing and the chemistry looks amazing. He asked about putting the date on the specials on the weekly email. Also asked about the leader in me habits if there was an overview of all of them. Next year we will do the habits in sequential order and each grade level will go over things a little differently based on development. - Data Review (Mcgreevy)- since our last meeting, we completed all of our PM2 data. When you look at reading data, we have been focused this year on our learning gains for our lowest students. We are happy to share that our lowest quartile we are already 20 points ahead of where we were last year. We are currently at 55% learning gains for our lowest quartile. We just refocused the students based on their needs. Our math looks lower however we took the test 4 weeks earlier. We are really proud of our staff for the work we have done. We have been looking closely at our ESE students, overall we are an A school however when we look at ESE we are a C school, we have been working with ESE and coaches to work with our ESE students. When we look at PM2 to PM2 knowing we took the test 4 weeks later we are really good.
