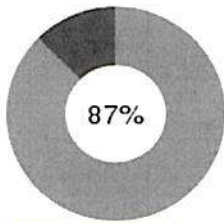

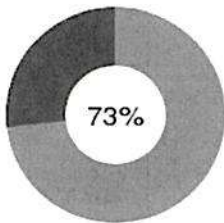

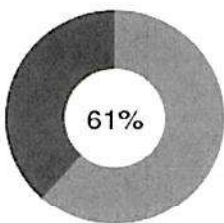

As the holiday season approaches, I would like to wish you and your family a very happy and joyful time together. This is a special season to pause, reflect, and cherish the moments we share with those we love. I encourage you to embrace each day, create new memories, and celebrate the bonds that make your family unique and strong.

This month, all students in Kindergarten to Gr. 5 will be administered the Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) Progress Monitoring 2 (PM2) assessment in Reading and Mathematics. FAST PM2 is the second of the three progress monitoring assessments, and it measures student growth in English Language Arts (ELA) Reading and Mathematics compared to the first progress monitoring assessment (PM1). It helps teachers and parents see mid-year performance levels and identify students who may need additional support to achieve end-of-year expectations, using benchmarks based on Florida's B.E.S.T. Standards. I am confident that our students will shine on their assessments but we need your support by ensuring that all students are present on their test days. The assessment schedule is included in this issue, along with research that supports the importance of students being present on their scheduled test days. Students who meet their PM2 goals will be rewarded with a very special treat; please feel free to contact your child's teacher for more information.

As always, thank you for choosing Discovery Elementary to educate your child and for being an important part of our school community.

I wish you peace, happiness, and wonderful memories throughout the holiday season and into the new year.

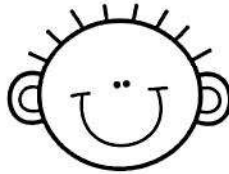

SAC/SAF Meeting Minutes

Wednesday, December 3, 2025

Welcome

Ms. Krystal Schechter, SAC Chair

The meeting was called to order by Krystal Schechter at 5:15 p.m. Ms. Schechter began by welcoming everyone to the SAC Meeting.

Reading and Approval of November Minutes

Ms. Schechter asks attendees to review the meeting minutes from the November meeting. With no questions, Ms. Schechter called for a motion to be approved the November meeting minutes. Ms. Patricia Louis-Mills motions to approve the meeting minutes from September. Ms. Anelle Moss seconds that motion. The November meeting minutes are approved.

Principal Updates Progress Monitoring

Dr. Ingrid Osgood, Principal

Accountability Funds: The updated balance is \$11,195.24

School Recognition Funds: The updated balance is \$17,020.00

Dr. Osgood explains additional funds were added to the account for instructional materials. Dr. Osgood requests to use the Accountability Funds for student recognition to celebrate academic achievement, instructional funding to purchase resources for ELO camps, staff recognition, and the procurement of teaching and learning resources for classroom instruction. Dr. Osgood opens the floor for questions and discussion. After a few clarifying questions, Dr. Osgood calls for a motion. Ms. Patricia Louis-Mills motions to approve the requested expenditures. Ms. Anelle Moss seconded the motion. With no one opposing the motion, the motion was carried and approved. Dr. Osgood makes an additional request to use the total funds from the School Recognition Fund towards the purchase of a new marquee with the difference to be taken from Accountability Funds. The cost of the marquee is \$19737. Dr. Osgood opens the floor for questions and discussion. After a few clarifying questions, Dr. Osgood calls for a motion. Ms. Carolyn Popescu motions to approve the requested expenditures. Ms. Jose Halley seconded the motion. With no one opposing the motion, the motion was carried and approved.

School Improvement Plan Presentation

Ms. Krystal Schechter, SAC Chair

Florida School Recognition Program (A+ Funds) Proposals

Ms. Schechter discusses the School Improvement Plan and presents the Florida School Recognition Program (A+ Funds). Ms. Schechter explains the voting process, presents an example of a previous voting ballot and guided the conversation to develop this year's ballot.

After discussing the ballot requirements, we opened the discussion to ensure clear communication regarding eligibility for the Florida School Recognition Program (A+ Funds). This included identifying the required percentage of the school year worked and clarifying the funding percentages allocated to teachers and the school. Following open discussion, the proposal of the voting ballot reflects three choices:

- Choice 1:
 - All Discovery Elementary employees from the 2024-2025 school year who completed at least 70% of the school year will equally share 85% of the School Recognition Funds. 15% of the funds will be used for student celebration incentives and/or supplemental materials and supplies. Leftover funds will go towards student incentives and supplies.
- Choice 2:
 - All Discovery Elementary employees from the 2024-2025 school year who completed at least 70% of the school year will equally share 100% of the School Recognition Funds. Leftover funds will go towards student incentives and supplies.
- Choice 3:
 - None of the Above












After discussion, Carolyn Popescu called a motion to approve the ballot as created by the SAC Committee and Ms. Halley seconded the motion. A roll call vote was conducted with the SAC board members. SAC members unanimously voted to approve the drafted ballot for this year's Florida School Recognition Program (A+ Funds). After approving the ballot, discussion was held informing the SAC members of the timeline of the voting. The staff meeting to discuss the ballot will be held on December 8th and the vote will be held on December 11th with one day for make up voting on December 12th.

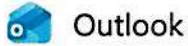

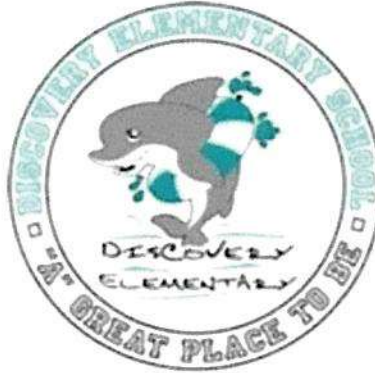
