### Welcome

The meeting was called to order at 5:35 pm. Ms. Schechter welcomes the attendees and introduces the SAF chair, Ms. Guerrier.

### Central Area Updates

Edlynn Guerrier

Ms. Guerrier welcomed the members and discussed items from the December Central Area Meeting at Indian Ridge Middle.

### Topics included:

- 200 Grant Funded positions, 100 deployable positions and 60 have been filled. 30 more staff eligible for deployment. This has helped 1200 students now have class coverage.
- Safety & Security: Final stages of security assessments. Concerns have been the length of time for this process is taking and concern about hiring freeze impacting security hires.
- Vendor Concerns: lengthy process to get signage and playground projects completed. 65% of playgrounds inspected. Elementary schools should have K-2 playground and 3-5 playground.
- PE Requirements: 150 minutes weekly and incorporate classroom movement to support this requirement.
