9th Grade Reading FSA Scores 2025-2026

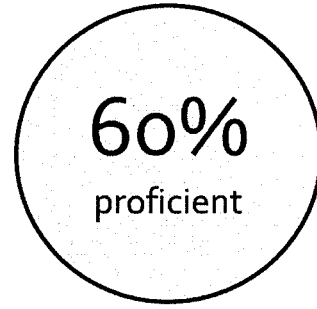
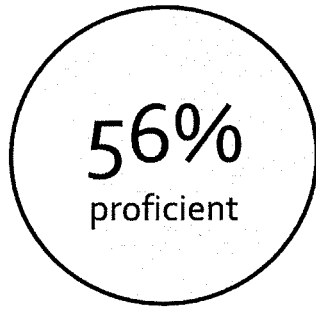


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9th Grade Reading FAST

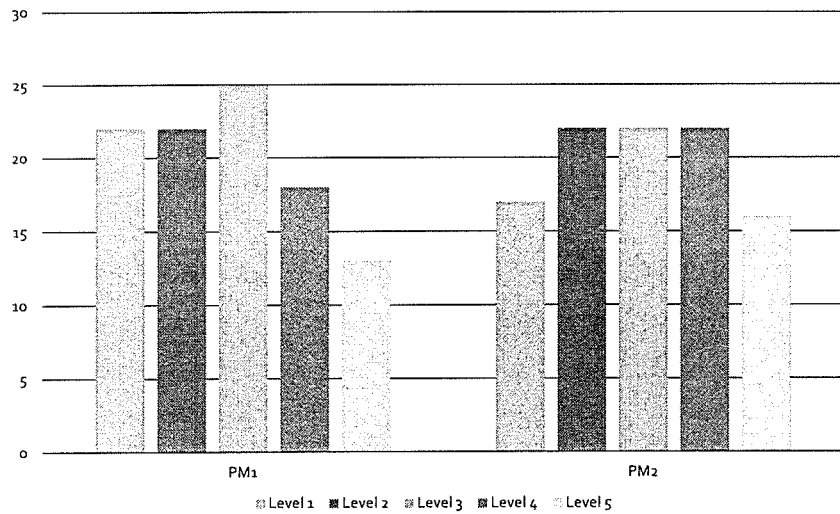

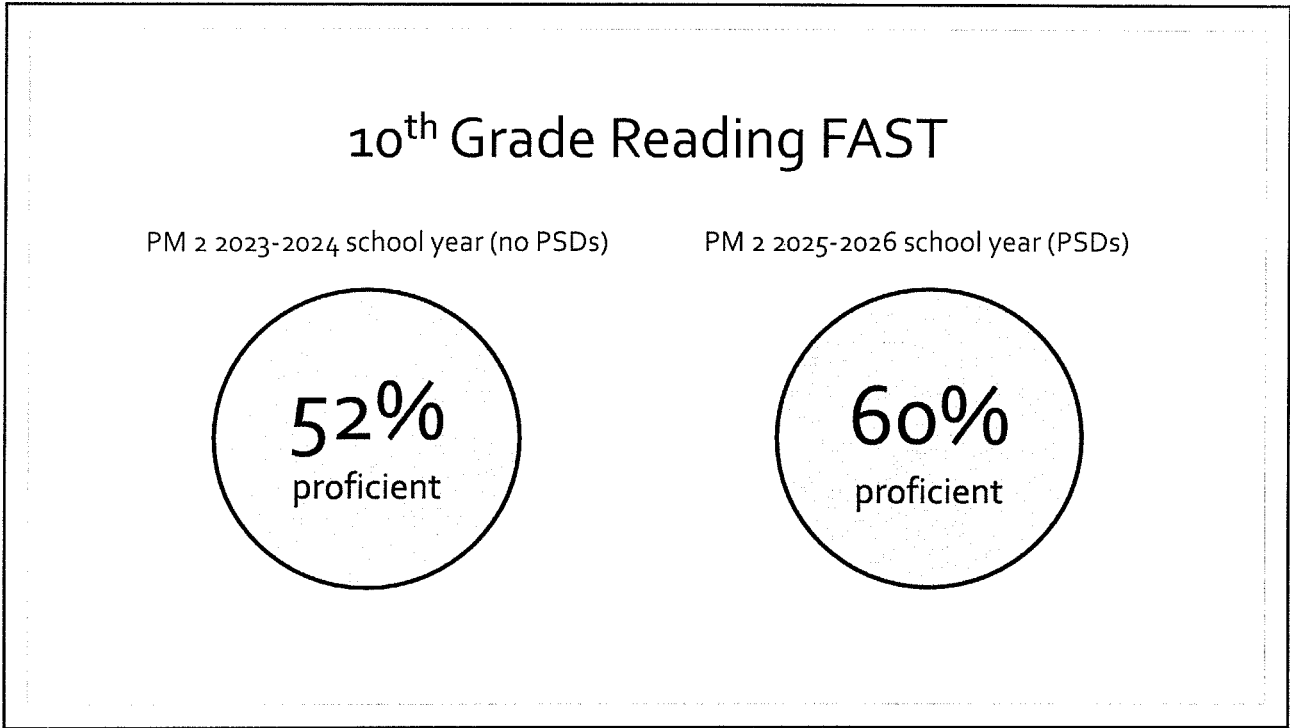


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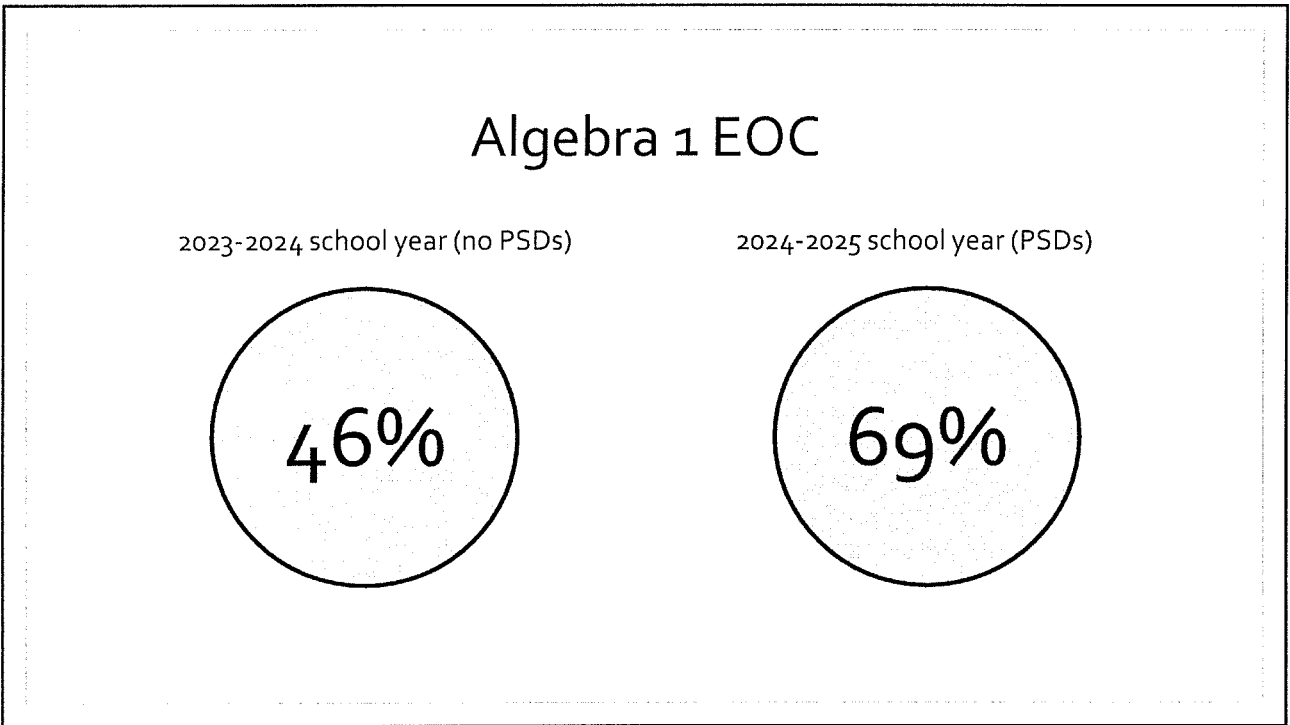
10th Grade Reading FSA Scores 2025-2026



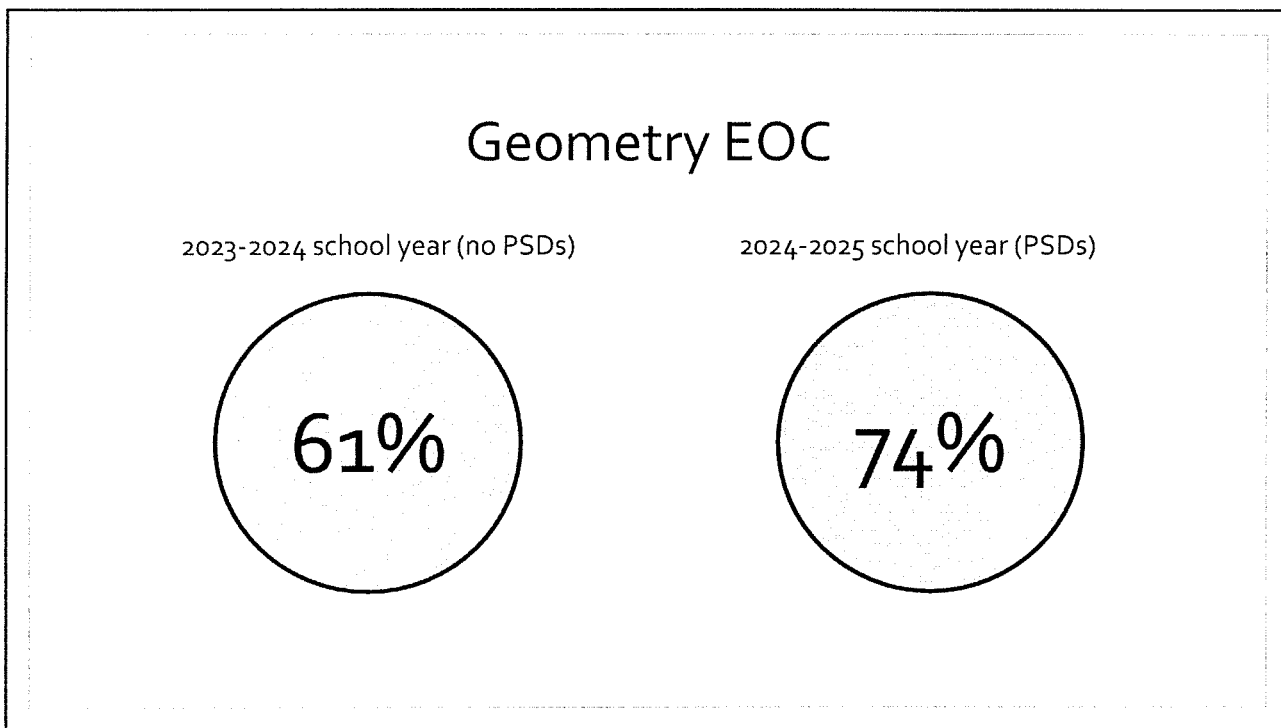
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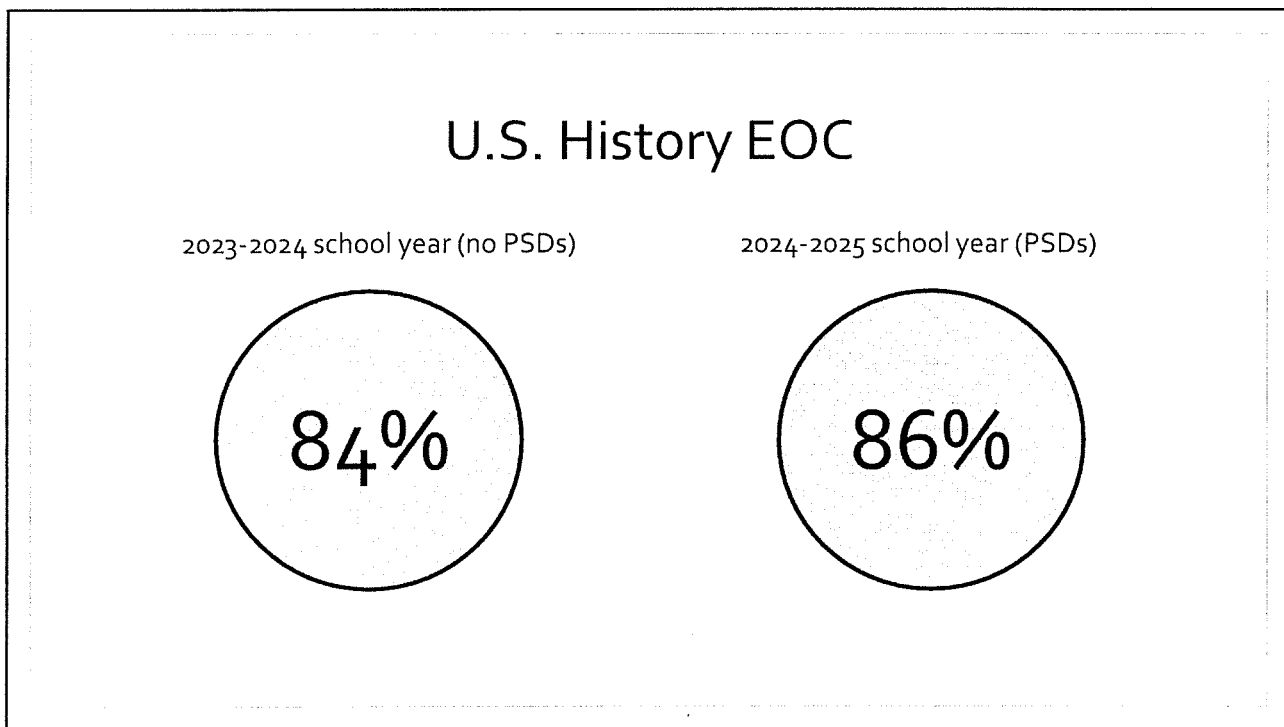
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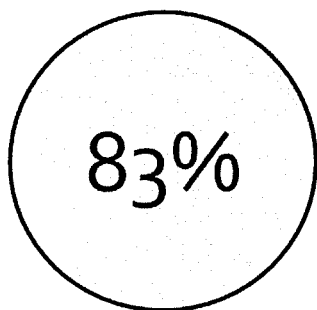
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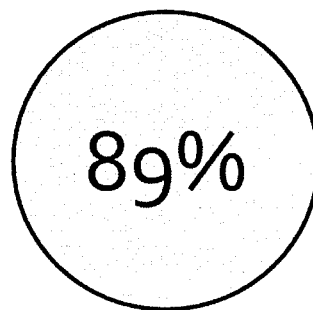
