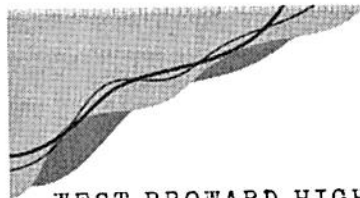

- Micah Moreno called the meeting to order at 3:43pm. Dianek Ventura will record minutes for this meeting.

**Approval of Minutes:**

**1. Principal Updates**

- a. Testing is going on now – AICE, AP, EOCs coming next week
- b. Newsletter went out with very important information
- c. Encourage children to prepare for testing
- d. Getting students ready for BIO, Math, English, etc

**3. New Business**

- a. 2025-2026 Budget Projections are being worked on
  - i. Went through a draft of the budget
  - ii. Funding is based on how many students are physically at school
  - iii. Students coming from FLVS and Private Schools in the area

Accountability Funds Currently Available: \$34,780.00

- iv. 2267 projections in Enrollment
  - 1. Does not include reassignment
  - 2. Total Projected Allocation: \$9,168,478
  - 3. 2400 students or so is what it is today
  - 4. Some cuts in number of classes but this is not final
  - 5. Ms Bristol is Chair of all the high schools. She is a budget expert and sits in all budget meetings for all high schools.
  - 6. The district will look at class sizes and make final decisions
  - 7. Accountability Funds will no longer be available (have not received since before COVID)
    - a. We cannot carry money over and will spend the funds as has been decided at other SAC meetings
  - 8. A+ funds will continue
- b. SAC Nominating Committee
  - i. 3 people to be on the committee
  - ii. Nominations: motion by Ms. Ventura, seconded by: Ms. Watson
    - 1. Ms Allen (Ms Ventura nominated)
      - a. Unanimous vote to approve
        - i. Ms. Allen is on the committee
    - 2. Ms. Moreno (Ms. Garcia nominated)
      - a. Unanimous vote to approve
        - i. Ms. Moreno is on the committee
    - 3. Ms. Blackshaw (Ms. Allen nominated)
      - a. Unanimous vote to approve
        - i. Ms. Blackshaw is on the committee
- c. SAC Composition Open Positions
  - i. SAC Composition reviewed
    - 1. Voting members
    - 2. Rules go with SAC Composition
      - a. 51% of the SAC Composition must be present
      - b. 51% must be non BCPS employees
      - c. Each racial group must be within - 20% represented at SAC – State Law
      - d. SAC Nominations will be in September during the first meeting of the year.
      - e. The more parents the better
