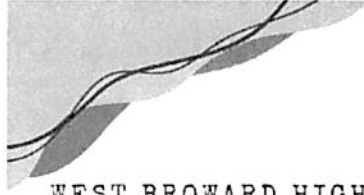

Attendance:

Call To Order:

A meeting of the _(West Broward High School)_ School Advisory Council was held in the (Media Center at 500 NW 209th Ave Pembroke Pines, FL 33029 on).

Micah Moreno called the meeting to order at 3:40pm. Laura Blackshaw recorded the minutes for this meeting.

Attendance: Ms. Moreno asked for parents, teachers and staff to introduce themselves, and welcomed new participants.

Approval of Minutes (April and May 2025): Motion to approve by Mrs. Isolino-Schindler. Second by Dianek Ventura. Approved.

1. Principal Updates

- a. Excited for Open House tonight
- b. Working on transcribing trophy information onto banners for the Media Center.
- c. Worked through the Summer with students:
 - i. Painting, cleaning and organizing areas on campus.
 - ii. Installed pavers, planted flowers and installed new carpet
- d. Ms. Bristol and Mr. Jones updating teacher planning areas
- e. Replacing and reupholstering furniture in the Media Center soon.
- f. Installed new sprinklers, in front and back of school.
- g. All positions are hired for campus.
- h. All existing teachers also had to be re-fingerprinted throughout the district.
- i. Students had the chance to change schedules during schedule pickup.
- j. Vet program will probably grow to 3 teachers next year to accommodate student demand.
- k. New EMT program is underway:
 - i. Hired dual enrollment teacher from Barry University.
 - ii. 23 students in EMT program now.
- l. No room for schedule changes at this point.
- m. Pass rates for AICE and AP are high from last year.
 - i. AICE pass rates were 80%; Most AP pass rates were 84%+, with 100% passing in Precalculus and Art.
- n. School grade is 50 points higher than previous year.
- o. Second highest Biology score in the district, behind Pompano.

- q. Met with several departments to discuss future growth:
 - i. Literacy goals: carve out reading time for comprehension, and cultivate passion for reading.
- 2. Homecoming dance is the night of September 27th
 - a. Capacity is 1300 students this year
- 3. Football: lost to nationally ranked 15th Corner Canyon Utah team last week.
- 4. Swim meet tomorrow
- 5. Exciting art news coming soon; teachers will announce.
- 6. Complaints about student drop-offs:
 - a. Can only control what happens in the school perimeter
 - b. Email sent to parents.
- 7. Common App Class for Students:
 - i. Students loved the Summer class; they finished entire Common App before school started
 - ii. Will have a repeat class on September 18th at 3pm.
- 8. Questions/Comments
 - a. Safety issue in the morning- parents parking in the drop-off lane.
 - i. Not enough personnel for policing parking or drop-offs.
 - b. Got 128 more students than anticipated from Spring's student projections.
 - c. Senior activities and products:
 - i. Grad Bash in April
 - 1. Have contracts for 9 buses in place.
 - 2. Need pricing from Universal to calculate price for students
 - ii. Prom in May
 - 1. Want Margaritaville as venue.
 - 2. Booking involves lengthy legal process with the district.
 - 3. After all expenses are tallied, then ticket price can be determined for students.
 - iii. Yearbook
 - iv. Senior Barbecue in May
 - v. Cap and gown: around \$45 through the company
 - d. Fall Sports: volleyball, football, cross country, swimming
 - e. All events covered in monthly newsletter and weekly e-mail blasts.

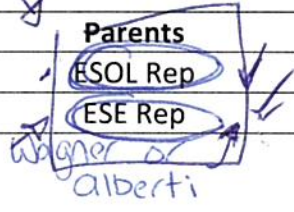
