January 21st, 2026**

1. Welcome and Pledge of Allegiance

- a. A meeting of Millennium 6-12 Collegiate Academy Advisory Council was held in the media center on January 21, 2026, at 6:03pm
 - i. Called to order—Mr. Byron Lee (Chair)
 - ii. Seconded by Mrs. T. Chin
- b. The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Review and Acceptance of December 4th, 2025, SAC minutes.

- a. Attendees reviewed the minutes for the December 2025 meeting.
 - i. Motioned – Ms. Lopez
 - ii. Seconded – Ms. Chin

3. Principal's Report—Dr. Harrigan

- a. Title 1 messaging to come later this week or by next meeting. We are close to meeting the state requirements of 65%, but need more parents to complete the form.
 - i. Deadline to meet criteria is Mid-February 2026
 - ii. A parent suggested we have volunteers target parents in the car line.
 - iii. Another parent suggested we make the messaging more targeted and specific.
- b. Rollover dollars taken from SAC last year, tonight we will vote for it.
- c. In February class selection for next year will begin, students will get a chance to choose their electives.
 - i. We offer a handful of electives but they are on a first-come, first-served basis.
 - ii. 80% of master schedule is completed by June, we are looking to add a Cybersecurity AP class as an elective.

4. School Improvement Plan: Mid-year Reflection:

- a. ELA PM1 50%, PM2 55% which is a 5% increase.
- b. Math PM1 20%, PM2 30%, which is a 10% increase.

5. School Accountability Funds \$10,002.00:

- i. Request for \$7000 for extended learning opportunity (ELO). Passed unanimously.
- ii. Request for \$3,002 PBIS and student incentives. Passed unanimously
- iii. Motion for voting by Ms. Lopez and seconded by Ms. Chin
