 - Please consistently discuss "See/Hear Something Say Something" with your child.
 - Encourage your children to use social media positively. It is not to be used to defame, embarrass, or bully their fellow students. These actions are far reaching and can cause emotional scars that never heal and police involvement.
- **Before & Afternoon School:** Please remind your child that once they are on campus in the morning, they cannot leave the school campus. In the afternoon, they cannot walk off campus with their friends and then try to return to campus. This is not allowed.
- **Reporting Incidents:** Please remind your child that if they know or are aware of planned fights or conflicts, they need to report them to their teachers, counselors, administrator, or security staff. Also, students will receive consequences if they are running toward or recording fights and incidents. Please review these expectations with your child.





Special School Advisory Council (SAC) Meeting Minutes
November 19th, 2025

1. Call to Order

- a. A meeting of Millennium 6-12 Collegiate Academy Advisory Council was held in the media center on 11/19/25. Mr. Richard Hoyer called the meeting to order at 6:10 p.m.

5. **A+ Money Incentive Presentation-** Mr. Lee presented the 3 most voted ideas from the staff and parents at Millennium 6-12 Collegiate Academy regarding the disbursement and dividends of the A+ funds. The initial ideas were shared to create the proposals below:

Option 1: *All staff including all district assigned personnel (social workers, psychologists, speech and language pathologist, student support instructional specialist, and family therapist and SRO) for the 24-25 school year will receive funds equally, provided they were here 51% of the school year.*

Option 2: *All staff including all district assigned personnel) personnel (social workers, psychologists, speech and language pathologist, student support instructional specialist, and family therapist and SRO) for the 24-25 school year will receive funds equally provided they were here 51% of the school year, with the following specifications: 10% allocated for ELO tutoring.*

Option 3: *None of the Above.*

After further discussions and modifications, the SAC members unanimously passed the proposed ballot below with 13 out of 19 votes. The following committee members voted:

Motion to approve the ballot by Ms. Chin seconded by Ms. Lopez. The proposed ballot below must be presented to the staff within 3 business days.

Option 1: *100% of the funds are for a one-time bonus all staff including all district assigned personnel for the 24-25 school year will receive funds equally, provided they were here 51% of the school year. All district assigned staff: social workers, psychologists, student support instructional specialist, family therapist and ESE Counselor will receive funds provided they work at least 2.55 days in a regular schoolwork week.*

Option 2: *10% of the funds go to the school **ELO Camp Tutoring**. 90% of the funds are for a one-time bonus all staff including all district assigned personnel for the 24-25 school year will receive funds equally, provided they were here 51% of the school year. All district assigned staff: social workers, psychologists, student support instructional specialist, family therapist and ESE Counselor will receive funds provided they work at least 2.55 days in a regular schoolwork week.*

Option 3: *None of the Above.*

The vote will begin on Tuesday, Dec. 2nd, 2025. As a reminder, for the Florida School Recognition Program (A+ Plus) vote to pass, all school employees currently on staff can cast a ballot. One more than half of the total school employees must vote. Employees absent on the day of voting should be allowed to vote on a secret ballot upon the day of their return or prior to their absences, if it is within a 24-hour period of actual voting.
