 - A few teachers were hired to cover urgent areas.
3. FAST Testing: PM2 is almost looking good as PM3 last year.
4. Hazel Health will exp June 30, 2026.
 - It was free service to the schools and students for the last 5 yrs.
 - No plans to renew.
 - If parents need to use the service for the children a consent form must be signed.
 - It is optional and can be revoke.
 - Parents should not receive any bills after service from Hazel Health.
5. There are currently 130 school Psychologist, and we are currently seeking to employ more.
6. Concerns were made regarding why some schools have only 1 security.
7. Dr. Fleming responded that we all are responsible to see something say something.
8. Those schools currently having more than 1 assistance principal will be adjusted based on number of enrollments. No Changes will be made to Guidance Counselors

16. Venues will remain as was last year.



