- e. 8th grade promotion has been redirected to the Community Church off Commercial Blvd.
- f. Preliminary budget for 2026-2027 is 3 SVE decreased to 2 and downsizing a support staff. Scheduled to get a VE class. Smaller self-contained class size approx. 15 students.
 - i. Scheduled to lose 2.5 positions.
 1. Need another student at the high school level
 2. Need additional electives for 8th grade.
