



**School Advisory Council (SAC) Meeting Minutes

**1. Welcome and Pledge of Allegiance**

- a. A meeting of Millennium 6-12 Collegiate Academy Advisory Council was held in the media center on October 22nd, at 6:07pm
  - i. Called to order—Mr. Byron Lee (Chair)
- b. The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**2. Review and Acceptance of September 24th, 2025 SAC minutes.**

**3. Principal's Report—Dr. Harrigan**

- a. We are currently at 61% of qualified free and reduced lunch recipients. Explained that Free and Reduced lunch is now based on payment and that only \$500 is placed in the principal's account to assist with students who need lunch. Title One status for the 2025-2026 school year was lost which also affects funding for the school and class sizes. This is due to the change in the percentage required to satisfy the requirement. So, from 58.2% to 62% to 65% and 4<sup>th</sup> year TBD. There were 5 positions that were lost under Title 1 and therefore will need to realign positions.
- b. Millennium 6-12 Collegiate Academy High School program explained that high school kids get their associate's degree and with the additional course to qualify for the AP Capstone Diploma if you score a 3 or higher on the AP test. Students that are 11<sup>th</sup> grade or below are required and they will get a Level 3 or high Course they will qualify for Bright Futures Scholarship.
- c. 80% of \$10,000 funds that was given by the City of Tamarac will be used for tutoring.
- d. There is a link to contribute to the new marquee. If you company or business would like to assist. Please make a donation for that. The culinary arts program needs donations to assist donating food.

the MOU, keeping the early days intact. Therefore, the school calendar will remain the same as announced in February.
