RULES

- 1. Public visitations should be encouraged. Visitors shall be directed to the administrative office where, when possible, they should be greeted by a principal. When desired and feasible, the principal or a designated representative shall accompany the guest(s) on a tour of school facilities and act as host or hostess.
- 2. Parents/guardians desiring to have a conference with a teacher should be encouraged to schedule their visits before or after school hours or during a period when the teacher is not responsible for teaching or supervising students.
- 3. It is expected that all school personnel shall practice the courtesy of advising the principal's office when they plan to be on campus.
- 4. There shall be no solicitation of teachers or students on school premises by salesmen, agents or others except with the approval of the Superintendent or his/her designated representative.
- 5. Every effort shall be made to exclude non-authorized individuals from school property at all times. Loitering on school premises during school hours by individuals not associated with the school shall not be tolerated. When it occurs, the appropriate Police Department or Sheriff's Department should be notified.
