CODE OF CONDUCT FOR ADMINISTRATORS

ALL ADMINISTRATORS SHALL CONDUCT THEIR SCHOOLS, CENTERS, COUNTY AND AREA DEPARTMENTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH APPLICABLE FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL LAWS, POLICIES, RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHILE MANY GUIDELINES ARE FURNISHED BY THE SOURCES MENTIONED ABOVE, IT IS REALIZED THAT NUMEROUS ACTS WHICH AN ADMINISTRATOR MUST DO ARE SUBJECT TO PROFESSIONAL JUDGMENT DECISIONS AND THEREFORE ARE SUBJECT TO CONTROVERSY AND DIFFERING OPINIONS. THE MAIN VALUE THAT SHALL BE HELD WHEN JUDGING AN ADMINISTRATIVE ACT IS THAT IT IS AIMED AT FOSTERING AND IMPROVING THE PROGRAM FOR WHICH THE ADMINISTRATOR IS DIRECTLY ACCOUNTABLE.

ANY VIOLATIONS OF LAW OR POLICY BY ADMINISTRATIVE PERSONNEL ARE SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINARY ACTION BY THE SUPERINTENDENT.
