INSURANCE - STUDENT LIABILITY INSURANCE

STUDENTS WHO DESIRE TO ENTER THE HEALTH OCCUPATION PROGRAMS OFFERED BY THE BOARD MUST OBTAIN, AT THEIR OWN EXPENSE, PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY COVERAGE AS A PREREQUISITE TO ADMISSION TO THE PROGRAM(S).

<u>RULES</u>

- 1. Student liability insurance shall be purchased via the School Board through the Risk Management and Safety Department.
- 2. The company selected by the Director of the Risk Management and Safety Department with the lowest and best proposal meeting specifications shall, upon approval of the School Board, deliver those supplies and materials necessary for the student to acquire such insurance. These materials and supplies shall be distributed by the individual schools to all students participating in the health occupation programs.
