## SUMMER SCHOOL

1. The location of summer school centers shall be determined by the School Board.
2. A minimum of 120 hours is required for one (1) credit or sixty (60) hours for one-half credit to comply with graduation requirements.
3. Noncredit summer programs of instructional enrichment also may be offered.
4. Principals in charge of summer school programs shall adhere to the policies, rules and regulations prepared annually by Instructional Services and Business Services in accordance with Florida State Board of Education Administrative Rules, Florida Statutes, and Board Policies, Rules and Regulations.
