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MIDDLE SCHOOL INTRAMURAL AND INTERSCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES

INTRAMURAL AND INTERSCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES SHALL BE AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE MIDDLE SCHOOL EDUCATION PROGRAM. NO INTERSCHOLASTIC PROGRAMS SHALL EXIST WITHOUT PRIOR INTRAMURAL ACTIVITY * OF THE SAME SPORT.

PERSONNEL SHALL BE PROVIDED TO STAFF THE INTRAMURAL AND INTERSCHOLASTIC PROGRAMS, THUS ALLOWING EACH SCHOOL TO RESPOND TO THE NEEDS OF ITS INDIVIDUAL COMMUNITY AND ITS STUDENT BODY.

RULES

- 1. In order for a school to have intramural and interscholastic activities, a physical education program must be provided.
- 2. In order to have an interscholastic activity, the same physical education and intramural programs must be provided.
- 3. A program director shall be designated to coordinate these activities.
- 4. Prior to any interscholastic program, a minimum of two weeks of intramurals of the same sport shall be provided.
- 5. No student shall be eliminated from interscholastic sports until after the first contest.
- 6. To provide equitable opportunities for students in the interscholastic programs, each school shall participate in a minimum number of sports for boys and girls as specified in the Constitution of the Gulfstream Conference of the Broward County Public Schools.
 - * Swimming would be an exception where facilities at the school are not available.
